A water resistant material may be able to get splashed or be dunked in a bucket of water for a short period of time; waterproof material has the capability to sit in water indefinitely without water getting through. The difference between bulletproof and ballistic is just that, but with bullets instead of water.

Here is how Webster Dictionary defines the difference between bulletproof and ballistic:

- Bulletproof: "Impenetrable to Bullets"
- Ballistic: "Capable of resisting or stopping bullets or other projectiles"

So what is our glass? Bulletproof or ballistic? While we'd like to admit that our glass is bulletproof, no glass in the world is impenetrable to bullets. That's why we like to emphasize the terms ballistic or bullet-resistant when we talk about glass. Our ballistic glass has the capability to stop bullets from striking through the glass; the stronger the level of glass, the stronger the bullets that it can resist.

To make glass as ballistic as possible, it can be made so thick that the light is warped and makes our views look blurry or skewed. Armitek has come up with a thinner ballistic glass that can withstand a bullet just as well with a clearer view that can fit comfortably in a commercial window frame.
